



2015 - 2016 Local School Plan for Improvement Beaver Ridge Elementary School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

The percentage of Beaver Ridge Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 achieving proficiency and/or distinguished on the mathematics, language arts, and science sections of the Georgia Milestones State Assessment will continue to increase each year.

- o **Annual Goal**

Beaver Ridge Elementary students in grades 3-5 will increase the average score on the English/Language Arts End of Year District Assessments from the 2015 administration to the 2016 administration by 5-10 percentage points. (See attached chart) All students in grades 1-2 will increase their reading level by at least one year of growth by the end of the year.

- o **Annual Goal**

Beaver Ridge Elementary students in grades 3-5 will increase the average score on the Mathematics End of Year District Assessments from the 2015 administration to the 2016 administration by 5-10 percentage points. Students in grades 1-2 will increase the average score on the Mathematics Student Performance Goals (SPGs) from the Beginning of the Year to the End of the Year. (See attached Chart)
