Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Trickum Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “proficient” and “distinguished” performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies to 100% by spring 2020.

o Annual Goal

Trickum Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in language arts with 65% of all students in grades 6-8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts.

o Annual Goal

Trickum Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics with 70% of all students in grades 6-8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Mathematics and Algebra I.

o Annual Goal

Trickum Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in science with 62% of all students in grade 8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Science, Physical Science and Biology.

o Annual Goal

Trickum Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in social studies with 65% of all students in grade 8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Social Studies.

• Long Term Goal

Trickum Middle School will increase the percentage of students meeting typical or high growth as measured in the Progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index to 100% by spring 2020.

o Annual Goal

All Trickum Middle School content areas will, by the end of the 2018-2019 school year, have averages in the top 7 of all GCPS middle schools on district assessments. Additionally, all students in all content areas will score 75% or higher on locally created common assessments.
