Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

By 2020-21, 75% of Mulberry Elementary students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of English/Language Arts.

- o **Annual Goal**

Mulberry Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range in grades K-2 on the EOY English/Language Arts District Assessment and in grades 3-5 on the Georgia Milestone English/Language Arts Assessment.

\*\*Kindergarten will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY English/Language Arts SPG to 56%.

\*\*1st grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY English/Language Arts District Assessment to 66%.

\*\*2nd grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY English/Language Arts District Assessment to 63%.

\*\*3rd grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 65% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones English/Language Arts Assessment.

\*\*4th grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 70% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones English/Language Arts Assessment.

\*\*5th grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 70% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones Math Assessment.

- **Long Term Goal**

By 2020-21, 75% of Mulberry Elementary students will score in the Proficient and Distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of Mathematics.



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#### o Annual Goal

Mulberry Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range in grades K-2 on the EOY Mathematics District Assessment and in grades 3-5 on the Georgia Milestone Mathematics Assessment.

\*\*Kindergarten will increase the percent of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY Math SPG to 74%.

\*\*1st grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY Math District Assessment to 93%.

\*\*2nd grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range on the EOY Math District Assessment to 75%.

\*\*3rd grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 72% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones Math Assessment.

\*\*4th grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 73% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones Math Assessment.

\*\*5th grade will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient/Distinguished range to 70% on the 2020 Georgia Milestones Math Assessment.
