Coleman Middle School among best in STEM competition

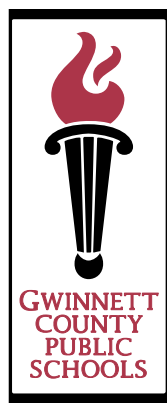
