## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. #### • Long Term Goal

K-5 students at Rock Springs Elementary School will demonstrate proficiency in reading comprehension and writing. 100% of 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will score in the Proficient and/or Distinguished range and at least 50% will score in the Distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in English Language Arts. Individual students will meet or exceed their expected levels of performance/growth on the GMAS ELA subtest.

##### o Annual Goal

Rock Springs Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the 2018 Georgia Milestones English Language Arts Assessment in third, fourth, and fifth grade by 5 percentage points per grade level.

##### o Annual Goal

Rock Springs will meet the following goals as measured by the District Assessments in the area of English Language Arts:

Grade 1: Increase the percentage of students scoring Distinguished in English Language Arts to 25% or more.

Grade 2: Increase the percentage of students scoring Distinguished in English Language Arts to 40% or more.

Grade 3: Increase the percentage of students scoring Distinguished in English Language Arts to 30% or more.

Grade 4: Increase the percentage of students scoring Distinguished in English Language Arts to 30% or more.

Grade 5: Increase the percentage of students scoring Distinguished in English Language Arts to 30% or more.

#### • Long Term Goal

K-5 students at Rock Springs Elementary School will demonstrate proficiency in mathematical concepts. 100% of 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will score in the Proficient and/or Distinguished range and at least 50% will score in the Distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in Mathematics. Individual students will meet or exceed their expected levels of performance/growth on the GMAS Math subtest.

##### o Annual Goal

Rock Springs Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the 2018 Georgia Milestones Mathematics Assessment in third, fourth, and fifth grade by 5 percentile points per grade level.

#### • Long Term Goal

College and Career Readiness:

The Collins Hill Cluster Schools will increase academic knowledge and skills for college and career readiness including focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), earning college credits, developing effective work and leadership habits, citizenship, and civic engagement, through transforming instructional practices.
