Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) offers high school students two ways to learn for credit this summer.

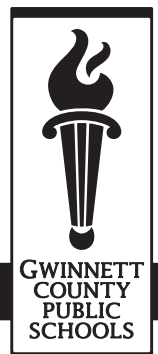

Important information for face-to-face and Online Campus summer school students...

- Transportation is not provided for face-to-face summer school classes or for the face-to-face sessions required for Online Campus courses.
- A student should take no more than two summer classes: two face-to-face classes, two online classes, or a combination.
- All tuition fees are due at the time of registration.
- Any student planning to participate in the summer school graduation ceremony on **July 13** must take all summer classes with Gwinnett County Public Schools.
- Face-to-face classes will **not** meet on **June 16, June 23, June 30, or July 4**.

MANDATORY face-to-face final exam for Health is scheduled for **June 26** (time TBD) at Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC).

Personal Fitness (PE)

MANDATORY fitness pre-test will be held on **June 1, June 2, or June 5** at GOC. Once registered, students should sign up for a fitness testing time at www.gwinnettonlinecampus.com/summer.html.

Students have two options for tracking PE workouts.

- **Fitbit HR Equipment** may be rented from GOC for an additional \$25 fee. Requires wearing Fitbit band during workouts. Lost equipment replacement is \$150. A limited number of slots are available for this option.
- Use free **Map My Fitness App** downloaded to a personal iPhone or Android device. Requires carrying or wearing phone during workouts.

MANDATORY face-to-face final exam and fitness post-test for PE is scheduled for **June 26** (time TBD) at GOC.

ALL CLASSES REQUIRE A FINAL EXAM. These tests are administered in a face-to-face session at Gwinnett Online Campus. Final exams for Health and PE are **June 26**, with final exams for all other courses on **June 28**, no exceptions. Students will return materials on exam day. Final exams count 20% of the total grade.

♦ **End of Course (EOC) Assessments:** As noted (♦) in the course list, designated courses also require a face-to-face, state-mandated End of Course (EOC) assessment. EOCs are administered in a face-to-face session at Gwinnett Online Campus. The EOC window is **June 22–28** (time TBD).

***Prerequisites:** As noted (*) in the course list, 1st and 2nd semesters of designated courses may not be taken concurrently during the summer session. Students must have successfully completed 1st semester prior to taking 2nd semester of a designated mathematics or science course.

Important Note: Course prerequisites listed here refer to Online Campus requirements. Additional course prerequisite information is listed in **The Choice Book**. Please talk to your counselor about all course requirements when considering your online schedule.

Frequently Asked Questions About Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC) Summer School

What is the cost of an Online Campus summer course?

Each online summer course is \$250.

How do I register and pay for online classes?

Register online at www.gwinnettonlinecampus.com under the **Programs-Summer** tab between **Feb. 13** and **May 24**. Online Campus only accepts payment by Mastercard/VISA prepaid, debit, or credit card; or by electronic check. Online Campus does not accept cash or personal checks. All GOC registration is handled online.

What are important dates for the Online Campus summer session?

Feb. 13–May 24 Online registration

June 5
(1–4 p.m.) Some courses require materials pick-up at Gwinnett Online Campus, located at 713 Hi Hope Road in Lawrenceville. *See the gray box inside for the list of courses that require materials pick-up.*

June 1, 2, or 5 For **Personal Fitness (PE)**, a mandatory face-to-face fitness pre-test will be held at the GOC gym facility (time TBD).

June 5 Students have access to their courses. Click on **“Summer Beginning of Term Information”** under the **Programs-Summer** tab.

June 5 **First day of class**

June 26 * Final Exams, Health and PE

June 28 * Final Exams, all other courses, no exemptions

June 22–28 EOC testing window, designated classes

July 13 Graduation Ceremony, Gwinnett Arena

* Check website and/or course announcements for date and time for EOCs and final exams. These mandatory tests are administered in face-to-face sessions at Gwinnett Online Campus.

What is the Beginning of Term Information?

*“Summer Beginning of Term Information” is part of the registration system in MyPaymentsPlus. When the course is selected in MyPaymentsPlus, the **Beginning of Term** letter will automatically pop up. The letter **requires** a signature confirming that the student has read and understands the information. This information also is available in the “Beginning of Term Information” link under the **Programs-Summer** tab on www.gwinnettonlinecampus.com.*

On **June 5**, students will access their online course through the **Logins** tab at www.gwinnettonlinecampus.com in the **Desire2Learn** login area. Students will use their GCPS student ID number for both their username and password.

Once logged in, students will see their course title and will click on the course title to enter the session homeroom.

By **June 5**, students will receive a welcome phone call from their teacher, or a welcome email sent to their [@gwinnettonlinecampus.com](mailto:gwinnettonlinecampus.com) email address, **NOT** to a personal email address. The teacher’s contact information also is posted on the course home page. Students are expected to check their GOC email daily during the summer session for important information.

How many online courses can I take at one time?

Online Campus allows students to take no more than two courses during the summer, including any face-to-face summer school classes. Online Campus does **NOT** allow students to take a full unit of any course when the first semester is a prerequisite for the second.

Do I have to log in to my course every day?

Yes, you must have *daily* access during the school week (Monday through Friday) to a reliable computer with an Internet connection. You will need to log in each class day during the entire summer session. An online course requires 16–20 hours a week per course during the shorter, more intensive summer classes. Students have access to their courses 24/7 during the summer session.

What is an online class like?

An online class is similar to a face-to-face class in the following ways. There is a teacher. You have lessons. You have homework, due dates, class discussions, and tests. The difference is that these activities occur over the Internet and students may “attend” class at any time of the day. However, you will need to log in each day during the school week (Monday through Friday) during the summer session.

What is the structure of a course?

For most classes, all class work is completed online. The exceptions are science and PE classes, which require additional face-to-face labs or activities. **All classes require a face-to-face final exam at the end of the semester.** For more information, see the demo course available on the website, and additional information in the Academic Departments section.

What if I want to withdraw and receive a course refund?

With parental approval, students can drop courses up until the posted **first day of class**. To request a refund, go to the GOC website and click on the **“Request a Refund”** link under the **Programs-Summer** tab. Refunds will be posted back to the prepaid/debit/credit card used or refunded to a bank account if paid by electronic check. No refunds will be given if requested after the posted first day of class.
