## **Two Gwinnett elementary schools to team up with Lowes and non-profit to build beds for families in need**

**On Saturday, October 26, Baggett Elementary School and Lilburn Elementary School** will team up with **Lowes** and **Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHP)** to build more than 100 beds for local families and hurricane victims. SHP is a non-profit organization that specializes in building beds for families in need. Its goal is to get children off floors and give them a good night's sleep.

Recently, SHP recently delivered four beds to a Baggett Elementary family. With this in mind, **Principal Charlotte Sadler** and her team felt this would be a great project for their school. She explains, "Seeing as Great Days of Service is coming up, we thought this would be a great opportunity for our staff to give back to our community through a project close to home... one that recently benefitted a family in our school community."

In addition to providing lunch, water, and volunteers for the project, Lowes also will donate \$25,000. In addition to volunteering for the build, the two elementary schools also are raising money to buy bedding and pillows for the new beds.
