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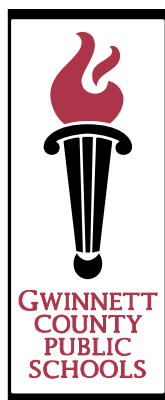
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GCPS educator among select group accepted into new LEGO education program

Kristin Williams-Luthi, a **Harbins Elementary School** teacher, has been selected to take part in the first cohort of the US [LEGO Education Master Educator program](#). Williams-Luthi is one of only 110 selected for the program which is designed for educators in early learning through secondary school who currently use LEGO hands-on learning solutions in their classroom.
