Local School Plan for Improvement GIVE Center West Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

GIVE Center West will increase the percent of students passing the local school and county Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies common assessments to 80% in 2014-2015; 83% in 2015-2016 and 85% in 2016-2017.

- **Long Term Goal**

GIVE Center West will increase the percent of students passing the local school and county math common assessments to 80% in 2014-2015; 83% in 2015-16 and 85% in 2016-17.

- **Long Term Goal**

Decrease the percentage of students who receive 2+ disciplinary referrals from 42% in 2013-2014 to 35% in 2014-2015; 30% in 2015-2016; and 25% in 2016-2017.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
