Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Knight Elementary will have 75% of students as proficient or distinguished learners in English Language Arts and Social Studies on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System by Spring 2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

At least 58% of Knight Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will score at proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in English Language Arts, with at least 20% percent of the students performing at the distinguished level.

- o **Annual Goal**

At least 50% percent of Knight Elementary School students in grade 5 will score at proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in Social Studies, with at least 20% of the students performing at the distinguished level.

- o **Annual Goal**

Knight Elementary School will increase our CCRPI score from 2018-19 by 3% or score in the top 25% of Georgia elementary schools in 2019-20.

- **Long Term Goal**

Knight Elementary will have 75% of students as proficient or distinguished learners in Mathematics and Science on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System by Spring 2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

At least 65% of Knight Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will score at proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in Mathematics, with at least 20% percent of the students performing at the distinguished level. 65% of students in 3rd grade will score at proficient or distinguished. 70% of students in 4th grade will score at proficient or distinguished. 65% of students in 5th grade will score at proficient or distinguished.

- o **Annual Goal**

At least 63% percent of Knight Elementary School students in grade 5 will score at proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Assessment System in Science, with at least 20% of the students performing at the distinguished level.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
