Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

All students attending Meadowcreek High School will graduate from high school within four years and one summer.

- **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek High School's four year cohort graduation rate will increase 5% from the final 2019 reported graduation rate.

- **Long Term Goal**

Students leaving Meadowcreek High School will use effective written and oral communication skills to define, describe, and solve complex problems. Meadowcreek High School students will score at or above the GCPS average on the Science and Social Studies Gateway exam.

- **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek High School will have an increase of 10% in all subgroups including ELL and SWD in science achievement as measured on the Gateway Writing Assessment, Biology EOC, while closing the gap with the overall district results by 10%.

- **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek High School will increase 10% student performance within all subgroups including ELL and SWD in the area of proficient and distinguished learners as measured by the 9th and 11th grade ELA EOC assessments and meets and exceeds areas on the Gateway Writing Assessment while closing the gap on district, SAT, and ACT assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

Meadowcreek High School students will effectively use mathematics skills and collaboration to solve novel problems and improve performance on multiple assessments. Meadowcreek High School students will score at or above the GCPS average on the Math and Science Georgia Milestones Assessments.

- **Annual Goal**

Meadowcreek High School will have an increase of 10% in Math achievement of all subgroups including ELL and SWD students as measured on the Algebra I and Geometry EOC, SAT, and ACT Exams while closing the gap with the overall district results by 10%.

- **Long Term Goal**

Meadowcreek High School will manage the School Improvement Grant (SIG) to ensure sustainability.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
