## Local School Plan for Improvement

### Five Forks Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Five Forks Middle School students will score in the "Proficient" or "Distinguished" range on the English/Language Arts and Mathematics objectives as measured by Georgia Milestones Assessments by Spring 2019.

- o **Annual Goal**

Five Forks Middle School Language Arts will, by the end of the 2017-2018 school year, increase the percentage of 6th-8th grade students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the End of Grade assessment to 70%.

- o **Annual Goal**

Five Forks Middle School Mathematics will, by the end of the 2017-2018 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the End of Grade assessment in 6th grade to 80%, in 7th grade to 80%, and in 8th grade to 50%. Additionally, the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the End of Course Algebra assessment will increase to 85%.

- **Long Term Goal**

One hundred percent of Five Forks Middle School students will meet typical or high growth as measured in the Progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index by Spring 2019.

- o **Annual Goal**

Five Forks Middle School 8th grade Science will, by the end of the 2017-2018 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished performance levels on the Physical Science End of Course assessment to 70%.

- o **Annual Goal**

All Five Forks Middle School content areas will, by the end of the 2017-2018 school year, have averages of 75% or higher on all county district post assessments for each semester and on locally created common assessments for grades 6-8. Additionally, all FFMS content areas will score in the top 7 for all GCPS schools on post district assessments.
