Local School Plan for Improvement

Summerour Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Summerour Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “proficient” or “distinguished” range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment or SPG test for English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics to 100% in 2021.

o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in language arts, math, science, and social studies according to the following criteria: 50% all students in grades 6-8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment and the science and social studies district assessments. The percentage of students scoring at the distinguished performance level will increase by 5%. In addition, students will score an average of 60% or higher on locally developed common assessments.

o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, Summerour will improve attendance by the following criteria: reduce the number of students absent by 30% and increase the average daily attendance rate to 97%.

o Annual Goal

Summerour's CCRPI score is 70.6. The targeted score was 72.2. Using the implementation design and targeted school plan, Summerour will increase its overall CCRPI score to meet the beating the odds threshold for the 18-19 school year. The goal is to increase the CCRPI score to 72.2 through an increase in points in Student Achievement.

o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, Summerour Middle School students enrolled in core connection and other connection classes will demonstrate mastery on SPGs according to the following criteria: 60% or more students scoring proficient and distinguished on the SPG assessment.

• Long Term Goal

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics and science with 100% of students scoring in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range on the Algebra EOC and Physical Science EOC in 2021..

o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, Summerour Middle School students enrolled in Algebra I, Accelerated Algebra I, or 9th-12th Physical Science courses will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance level by 10% or higher, with at least 50% of our students scoring in the distinguished performance level.

• Long Term Goal

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
