Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

All Jackson Elementary students will demonstrate mastery of the elementary Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies AKS as indicated by 100% of students scoring in the proficient/distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment. In order to achieve this goal, the faculty of Jackson Elementary will build instructional leadership around curriculum, instruction, and assessment and will use student assessment data to drive instruction using Quality-Plus Teaching Strategies.

- o **Annual Goal**

Annual Goal 1: During the 2020-2021 school year, all students will score 70% or higher on English/Language Arts district unit assessments.

Annual Goal 2: During the 2020-2021 school year, all students will score 70% or higher on the Mathematics district unit assessments.

Annual Goal 3: During the 2020-2021 school year, all students will score 70% or higher on the Science district unit assessments.

Annual Goal 4: During the 2020-2021 school year, all students will score 70% or higher on the Social Studies district unit assessments.
