## Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Student Achievement:

Student performance on AP, SAT, ACT, GA Milestones, Gateway, and District Assessment measures will increase as a reflection of Collins Hill High School's strategic focus on mindsets for raising student achievement with specific targets in literacy and math.

- o **Annual Goal**

Collins Hill School will increase its academic performance in all core academic areas for ALL students to meet and/or exceed annual targets as indicated by district and state measures. This will be accomplished while striving for a 2 point gain on the College Career Readiness Performance Index measure and a 5 point gain on the GCPS Weighted School Assessment.

- **Long Term Goal**

Graduation Rate:

Collins Hill High School will improve its 4 year cohort graduation rate to 92% by 2022.

- o **Annual Goal**

Collins High School will have an 88% graduation rate for 2019-2020 school year.

- **Long Term Goal**

College and Career Readiness:

The Collins Hill Cluster Schools will increase academic knowledge and skills for college and career readiness including a focus on earning college credits, developing professional skills, and increasing citizenship and civic engagement by transforming instructional practices.

- o **Annual Goal**

For the 2019-2020 school year, seniors earning college credits will rise by 3% and those earning college and career pathways will rise by 3%. The student body will have an 80% civic participation rate in service learning, work based learning, and extra curricular/co-curricular activities.
