## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Summerour Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “proficient” or “distinguished” range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment or SPG test for English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics to 100% in 2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Language Arts with 45% of students in grade six, 45% of students in grade seven, and 45% of students in grade eight scoring at or above the proficient level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment and the GCPS district assessments with 18% of sixth, 15% of seventh, and 15% of eighth grade students scoring distinguished.

- o **Annual Goal**

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Math with 45% of students in grade six, 50% of students in grade seven, and 45% of students in grade eight scoring at or above the proficient level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment and the GCPS district assessments with 18% of sixth, 18% of seventh, and 20% of eighth grade students scoring distinguished.

- o **Annual Goal**

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Science with 40% of students in grade eight scoring at or above the proficient level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment and the GCPS district assessments with 20% of eighth grade students scoring distinguished. In addition, 45% of students in sixth and 45% of students in seventh will demonstrate mastery by scoring at or above the performance level on the GCPS district assessments with 25% of sixth and 25% of seventh scoring distinguished.

- o **Annual Goal**

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Social Studies with 45% of students in grade eight scoring at or above the proficient level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Social Studies and the GCPS district assessments with 20% of eighth grade students scoring distinguished. In addition, 45% of students in sixth and 60% of students in seventh will demonstrate mastery by scoring at or above the performance level on the GCPS district assessments with 25% of sixth and 30% of seventh scoring distinguished.

- o **Annual Goal**

Summerour Middle School will increase our CCRPI score from 2018-19 by 3% or score in the top 25% of Georgia middle schools.

- **Long Term Goal**

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics and science with 100% of students scoring in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range on the Algebra EOC and Physical Science EOC in 2021..
