## Local School Plan for Improvement

### Patrick Elementary School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

100% of Patrick students will meet or exceed annual performance targets for performance/growth on the Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies in the Georgia Milestone End of Grade Assessments. A minimum of 50% of all students will perform in the distinguished achievement level by the 2019-2020 school year.

- o **Annual Goal**

Patrick Elementary students will demonstrate mastery of the AKS in Numeracy as measured by 75% of our students scoring at the Proficient/Distinguished Level on Milestones Assessments in Math.

- o **Annual Goal**

Patrick Elementary students will demonstrate mastery of the AKS in Literacy as measured by 75% scoring at the Proficient/Distinguished Level on Milestones Assessments in English Language Arts.

- o **Annual Goal**

Patrick Elementary students will demonstrate mastery in application of the AKS through critical thinking as measured by 75% scoring Proficient/Distinguished Level on Milestones Assessments in Science and Social Studies.

- **Long Term Goal**

Patrick Elementary School will transform teaching and learning through collaboration which creates and sustains engaged learners through rigorous instructional practices such as project base learning, and stem integration and writing across the curriculum resulting in high student achievement for all students by the 2019-2020 school year. Progress will be monitored through individualized professional development growth, informal feedback, surveys, coaching, observations, and data analysis.

- o **Annual Goal**

Patrick Elementary students will meet or exceed the state Subgroup performance level target as projected for each year on the CCRPI.
