Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase academic performance in English Language Arts and the application of these skills by increasing the percentage of students performing in levels 3 and 4 on the Georgia Milestones Assessment to 90% by June 2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient (level 3) and Distinguished (level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in English Language Arts by 3 percentage points over 2016-2017 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in these two top levels by 6% over 2016-2017 results.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase academic performance in Mathematics and the application of math skills by increasing the percentage of students performing in levels 3 and 4 on the Georgia Milestones Assessment to 90% by June 2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient (level 3) and Distinguished (level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Mathematics by 3 percentage points over 2016-2017 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in these two top levels by 6% over 2016-2017 results.

- **Long Term Goal**

The Brookwood Cluster will increase rigor for all students to reach their greatest potential through appropriate acceleration and integration in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math. Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students performing in levels 3 and 4 to 90% in math on the Georgia Milestones Assessment and to 80% on the science Georgia Milestones Assessment by June 2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient (level 3) and Distinguished (level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Science by 3 percentage points over 2016-2017 results in grade 5 which is acceptable progress. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in these two top levels by 6% over 2016-2017 results.
