## **Brookwood to represent GA in national science competition**

**Brookwood High School's** Science Olympiad team will represent Georgia at the **2018 National Science Olympiad** next month. Brookwood High earned the honor after defeating 24 of the best teams in Georgia on the way to winning its 10<sup>th</sup> State Science Olympiad title. In the most dominant win in school history, this year's team earned recognition in all 23 events, a first in the history of the program. The six first-place finishes tied a school record and students/teams finished second in eight categories. Brookwood High's team score of 70 is the best in school history, coming in 43 points above Chattahoochee High School and 72 points above Gwinnett School of Mathematics, Science, and Technology which finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, respectively.
