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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. Summerour Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “proficient” or “distinguished” range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment or SPG test for English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics to 100% in 2019-2020.

Summerour Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics and science with 100% of students scoring in the "proficient" or "distinguished" range on the Algebra EOC and Physical Science EOC in 2019-2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2017-2018 school year, Summerour Middle School students enrolled in Algebra I, Accelerated Algebra, and Accelerated Physical Science will demonstrate mastery on local and district assessments according to the following criteria: 70% or more students scoring proficient and distinguished on the District Assessments and End of Course Test.
