## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. #### • Long Term Goal

Our goal at Chattahoochee Elementary School is to increase the percentage of students performing in the Proficient Learners and Distinguished Learners on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts and Mathematics to 100%.

#### o Annual Goal

Chattahoochee Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient (Level 3) and Distinguished (Level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in English Language Arts. Acceptable progress would be a gain of at least 3 percentage points over 2017-2018 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in these two top levels by at least 5 percentage points over 2017-2018 results.

The following scores would reflect acceptable progress:

Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 61.

Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 67.

Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 61.

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 63.

Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 70.

Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 63.

In addition, Chattahoochee Elementary will increase the percentage of students (by at least 3 points) achieving at the Proficient (Level 3) and Distinguished (Level 4) on the English/Language Arts End-of-Year SPG/District Assessments in First - Fifth grades (and increase the percentage of students reading at Level D at the end of Kindergarten by 3 points).

The following scores represent the increases on the SPG/DA Assessments:

Kindergarten - Increase the percentage of students reading at Level D on the Fountas/Pinnell Reading Assessment to 85%.

First Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 65%.

Second Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 67%.

Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 77%.

Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 70%.

Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 59%.



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#### o Annual Goal

Chattahoochee ES Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient (level 3) and Distinguished (level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Mathematics. Acceptable progress would be to meet 2017-2018 results in grade levels 3, 4, and 5. Excellent progress would be to increase the percentage of students scoring in these two top levels by at least 5 percentage points over 2017-2018 results.

The following scores would reflect acceptable progress:

Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 70.

Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 58.

Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 56.

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 73.

Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 60.

Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 58.

In addition, Chattahoochee Elementary will increase the percentage of students (by at least 3 points) achieving at the Proficient (Level 3) and Distinguished (Level 4) on the Math End-of-Year SPG/District Assessments in all grades.

- Kindergarten - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 81%.
- First Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 89%.
- Second Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 83%.
- Third Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 78%.
- Fourth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 73%.
- Fifth Grade - Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 75%.
