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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

100% of Stripling Elementary School students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will achieve Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies content areas of the Georgia Milestones State Assessment.

- o **Annual Goal**

Stripling will increase Math SPG/ End of Year District Assessment results by 10 percentage points for each grade level, resulting in 10 percentage points increase in meets and 5 percentage points increase for exceeds categories. (Attached data includes specific grade level goals.)

- o **Annual Goal**

Stripling will increase ELA District Assessment End of Year District Assessment results by 10 percentage points for each grade level, resulting in 10 percentage points increase in meets and 5 percentage points increase for exceeds categories. (Attached data includes specific grade level goals.)

- o **Annual Goal**

Stripling Elementary will increase post-test District Assessment results in Science by 10 percentage points over 2014-2015 post-test results for grades 3-5, resulting in 10 percentage increase in the number of students performing in the meets and exceeds categories respectively.

- o **Annual Goal**

Stripling will increase post-test District Assessment results in Social Studies by 10% over 2014-2015 post-test results for grades 3-5.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
