Local School Plan for Improvement

Creekland Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Creekland Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the “Proficient Learners” or “Distinguished Learners” range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts and Mathematics to 100% in 2018-19.

- o **Annual Goal**

Teachers will show an increase in the effective use of technology as measured by the eCLASS matrix.

- o **Annual Goal**

Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in language arts with 75% of all students in grades 6-8 scoring in the “proficient” or “distinguished” performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Math.

- **Long Term Goal**

Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics with 100% of students scoring in the "Proficient Learners" or "Distinguished Learners" range on the coordinate algebra state assessment in 2018-2019 and mastery in physical science with 100% of students scoring in the "Proficient" or "Distinguished" range on the physical science state assessment in 2018-19.

- o **Annual Goal**

Creekland Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in math with 70% of all students in grades 6-8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Math.

- o **Annual Goal**

Creekland Middle School 6th and 7th grade students will demonstrate mastery in science with 75% of students scoring in the "Proficient" or "Distinguished" range on the district assessment post-tests. Creekland Middle School 8th grade students will demonstrate mastery in science with 70% of students scoring in the “Proficient” or “Distinguished” range on the Physical Science EOC.

During the 16-17 school year, Creekland Middle School students will score 80% or higher on all county district assessments and locally created common assessments for language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies.
