Local School Plan for Improvement

Shiloh High School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase its graduation rate to 88% in 2019-2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase its cohort graduation rate from 76% to 88% in 2019-20.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School's passing rate for first time testers on the Gateway Social Studies and Science will increase to 90% or higher by 2019-2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of students succeeding on the Gateway will increase in the meets and exceeds level from 64% to 72% in Social Studies and from 59% to 70% in Science.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will increase the pass rate annually for all End of Course assessments, District Assessments and/or SPG's and End of Pathway Assessments by 5% or higher as well as state and national assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve student achievement by meeting or exceeding the district average on End of Course (EOC) Assessments. This will be formatively monitored by performance on District Assessments.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will improve it's overall CCRPI goal to 80% by 2023-24.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School student participation in accelerated programs to include but not limited to International Baccalaureate (IB) and Advanced Placement will increase by 25% in 2022.

- **Long Term Goal**

Shiloh High School will continue to improve its student performance and participation in IB and AB advanced courses.

Shiloh High School will improve its CCRPI score from 67% to 72%.
