



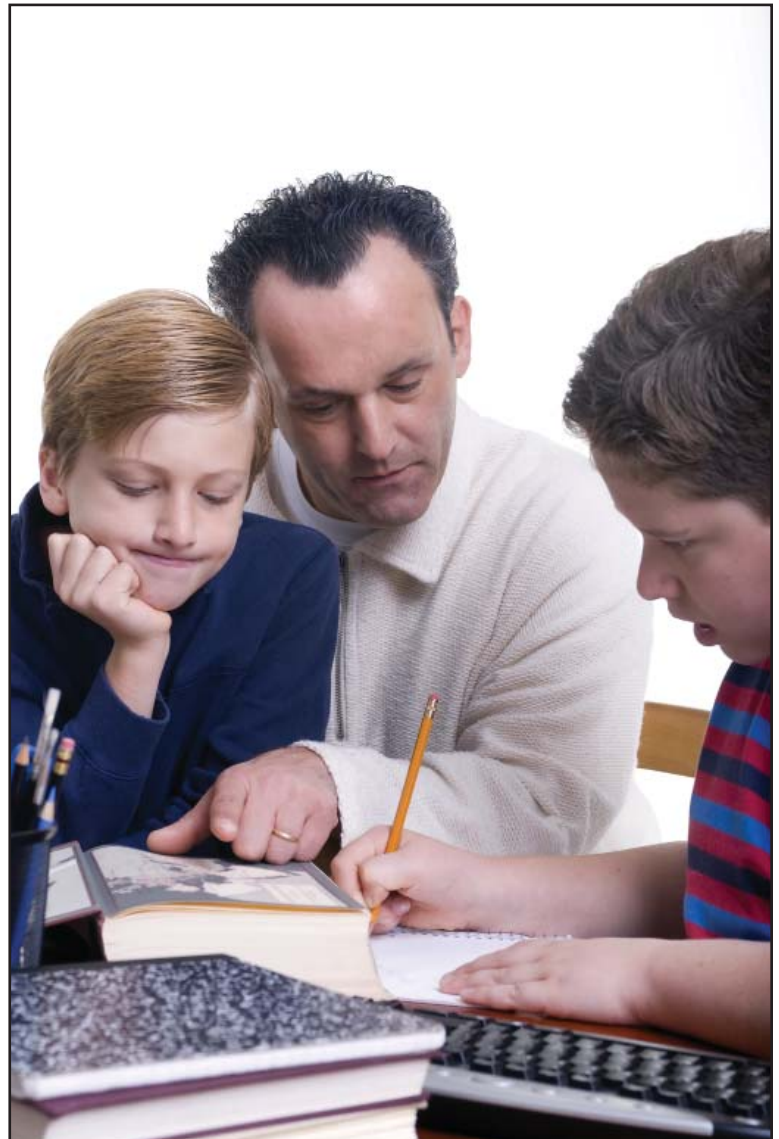
Tips for Involved Parents from Gwinnett County Public Schools
