## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Bay Creek Middle School will increase the percentage of students performing as Proficiency Learners and/or Distinguished Learners on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts and Mathematics to 100% in 2018-2019.

- o **Annual Goal**

All students will show typical or high growth and 40% will show distinguished growth in all academic and connection classes as measured by their performance growth from the pre-test to the post test on the district assessments each semester. In addition, 100% of gifted learners will reach high or distinguished growth from their pre to post assessments. Typical growth is defined as an increase of 30% from pretest to post-test, high growth is defined as an increase of 45% from pretest to post-test, and distinguished growth is defined as an increase of 65% from pretest to post-test.
