Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

One hundred percent of Crews Middle School students will achieve Proficient or Distinguished for English Language Arts and Mathematics objectives as measured by state assessments by Spring 2019.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School Language Arts students will by the end of the 2016-2017 school year, increase the percentage of 6th grade students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished on the End of Grade assessment to 75% and in 7th and 8th grades to 80%.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School Mathematics students will by the end of the 2016-2017 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the End of Grade assessment in 6th grade to 80%, in 7th grade to 83%, and in 8th grade to 60%. Also, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the End of Course Algebra assessment to 100%.

• Long Term Goal

One hundred percent of Crews Middle School students will meet typical or high growth as measured in the Progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index by Spring 2019.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School students will by the end of the 2016-2017 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring Grade Level or Above in Reading on the End of Grade assessment in 6th grade to 90%, in 7th grade to 95% and in 8th grade to 97%.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School 8th grade Science students will by the end of the 2016-2017 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the Physical Science End of Course assessment to 72%. They will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories to 85% in 6th grade and 90% in 7th grade as measured by district assessments.

o Annual Goal

Crews Middle School Social Studies students will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories in 6th grade to 70% and in 7th grade to 82% as measured by district assessments. Crews Middle School Social Studies students will increase the percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Distinguished categories on the 8th grade End of Grade assessment to 80%.
