Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Britt Elementary will demonstrate increased academic performance in the skills necessary for English Language Arts and Mathematics by increasing the percentage of students performing in the Distinguished and Proficient categories of the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessments to 65%.

- **Annual Goal**

Britt Elementary will increase the percentage of students in fourth and fifth grades achieving at Proficient (level 3) or Distinguished (Level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessments in English Language Arts and Mathematics by 5% over their 2017-2018 results. At least 50% of the students in third grade will score at Proficient (level 3) or Distinguished (Level 4) on the Georgia Milestones Assessments in English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Students in Kindergarten, first, and second grades will meet or exceed the district assessment post-test average in English Language Arts (grades 1-2) and Mathematics (grades K-2).

- **Long Term Goal**

The South Gwinnett Cluster will measure beyond the state of Georgia's highest performance level, by five percentage points for math, as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment System, in grades 3-8, Coordinate Algebra and Analytical Geometry.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
