Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Jones Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the "proficient" and "distinguished" range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Algebra I, Physical Science, and Social Studies to 100% and will increase the percentage of students scoring in the "distinguished" range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Algebra I, Physical Science, and Social Studies to 50% in 2019-2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Each Jones Middle School student will score 85% or higher and/or rank in the Top 5 of all GCPS middle schools on GCPS Interim and Post-Test Assessments in Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.

- **Long Term Goal**

Jones Middle School will score in the "Top 5" of all GCPS middle school on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Physical Science, and Social Studies in 2019-2020.

- o **Annual Goal**

Jones Middle School will achieve Level 2/Developing on the Matrix of eClass Implementation and our locally developed rubric in all domains for the 2016-2017 school year.
