

History of

Mill Creek High School

Mill Creek opened in August 2004 with approximately 2,500 students. The school has grown in three years to the point where it served more than 3,600 students in 2006–07. Our school colors are cardinal, vegas gold, and navy. Students designed our crest which contains the motto “Honestas/Fidelitas/Virtus,” meaning Honor, Loyalty, and Personal Integrity. Our Alma Mater was written by student Phillip Reeseman in September 2004. The Mill Creek mascot is the Hawk. The mascot was chosen from a list of six animal candidates. The fight song was written by the school’s first band director, William McKay. The school has grown by more than 600 students in each of its three years, and anticipates a 2007–08 enrollment of approximately 4,200 students. The school name was selected by a group of Gwinnett citizens that actually remembered when there was an active corn/grist mill on Duncan Creek.
