## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Student Achievement--National, State, and Local Standardized Tests:

Student performance on AP, SAT, ACT, GA Milestones, Gateway, and Student Performance Goal measures will increase as a reflection of Collins Hill High School's focus on student achievement with specific targets on Economically Disadvantaged students in Language Arts and Math.

- o **Annual Goal**

Academic Achievement for All Students: Collins Hill High School will increase academic performance in the core academic areas for ALL students to meet and/or exceed annual targets as indicated by district and state measures, while striving for a 2 point gain on College Career Readiness Performance Index measures (after conversion to new standard for ESSA) and a 5 point gain on the GCPS Weighted School Assessment.

- **Long Term Goal**

Graduation Rate:

Collins Hill High School will improve the 4 year cohort graduation rate to 92% by 2019.

- o **Annual Goal**

The 2018 4 year cohort rate was at 83.3%. The goal for the 2019 Cohort graduation rate is 92%.

- **Long Term Goal**

College and Career Readiness:

The Collins Hill Cluster Schools will increase academic knowledge and skills for college and career readiness including a focus on earning college credits, developing work habits, and increasing citizenship and civic engagement, by transforming instructional practices.

- o **Annual Goal**

Seniors earning college credits in 17-18 school year was 53.31%, and those completing an advanced academic, world language, fine arts or career technical pathway was 79.21%. For the 18-19 school year seniors earning college credits will rise by 3%, and those earning college and career pathways will rise by 3%. The student body will have a 80% civic participation rate in service learning, work based learning, extra curricular and co-curricular activities.
