Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

100% of Graves ES students will perform at the proficient or distinguished achievement levels on the Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies Georgia Milestones sub tests.

- o **Annual Goal**

Language Arts-Graves Elementary School will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguished levels on the Language Arts portion of the Georgia Milestones.

The goal in 3rd grade is to increase from 34% to 38% scoring proficient or distinguished.

The goal in 4th grade is to increase from 28% to 41% scoring proficient or distinguished.

The goal in 5th grade is to increase from 31% to 39% scoring proficient or distinguished.

Graves Elementary School will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguished levels on the Language Arts portion of the quarterly District Assessments.

The goal in 1st grade is to meet or exceed 30% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 2nd grade is to meet or exceed 30% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 3rd grade is to meet or exceed 50% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 4th grade is to meet or exceed 40% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 5th grade is to meet or exceed 30% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

o Annual Goal

Mathematics Goal-Graves Elementary School will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguished levels on the Mathematics portion of the Georgia Milestones.

The goal in 3rd grade is to increase from 42% to 51% scoring proficient or distinguished.

The goal in 4th grade is to increase from 43% to 52% scoring proficient or distinguished.

The goal in 5th grade is to increase from 27% to 42% scoring proficient or distinguished.

Graves Elementary School will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguished levels on the Mathematics portion of the quarterly District Assessments.

The goal in 1st grade is to meet or exceed 80% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 2nd grade is to meet or exceed 55% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 3rd grade is to meet or exceed 45% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 4th grade is to meet or exceed 45% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.

The goal in 5th grade is to meet or exceed 35% of our students scoring in the proficient or distinguished range on the district assessments.
