Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase ALL students' academic performance in Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies on all state and district assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the percent of all 9th grade students scoring in the Proficient or Distinguished Learner categories by 2% as measured by their performance on the Biology, Algebra I, Geometry, and Language Arts End of Course (EOC) test. Strategic and targeted focus on the success of 9th grade students allows us to focus on the success of all students throughout their high school careers.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase its 4-year cohort graduation rate to 96% by 2020-2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase its 4-year graduation rate, including summer graduates, as measured by the cohort analyzer from the projected 94% to 95% for the 2019-2020 School Year.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase student performance on the SAT as measured by local and national standards.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the overall mean SAT score from projected combined scores of 1149 to 1155 through targeted interventions and instructional opportunities for all students.
