Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase ALL students' academic performance in Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the academic performance of ALL students as measured by their performance on the EOC. EOC scores directly impact the Achievement Content Mastery category of the CCRPI. This goal will be measured by an increase of students scoring in the Proficient and/or Distinguished Learner categories by a combined 2% for the following EOC courses: 9th Literature and Composition, 11th American Literature and Composition, Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, US History, and Economics.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the 4 - year cohort graduation rate.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the 4-year graduation rate, including summer graduates, as measured by the cohort analyzer from the projected 92% to 94.0% for the 17.18 SY.

- **Long Term Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase student performance on the SAT.

- o **Annual Goal**

Brookwood High School will increase the overall mean SAT score by 2% from 1141 to 1163 through targeted interventions and instructional opportunities for all students.
