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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

Bay Creek Middle School will increase the percentage of students performing as Proficiency Learners and/or Distinguished Learners on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts and Mathematics to 100% in 2020-2021

- o **Annual Goal**

Bay Creek Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in language arts, math, science and social studies as demonstrated by an increase of 4% of all students in grades 6- 8 scoring in the proficient or distinguished performance levels on the GMAS EOG and EOC Assessments.

Additionally, Bay Creek Middle School students will demonstrate mastery of the AKS by achieving an average score ranking in the top 5 of GCPS middle schools on District Post Assessments.
