Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Student Achievement--National, State, and Local Standardized Tests:

Student performance on AP, SAT, ACT, GA Milestones, Gateway, and Student Performance Goal measures will increase as a reflection of Collins Hill High School's focus on student achievement with specific targets on Economically Disadvantaged students in Language Arts and Math.

o Annual Goal

Academic Achievement for All Students: Collins Hill High School will increase academic performance in the core academic areas for ALL students to meet and/or exceed annual targets as indicated by the district and state measures, while striving for a 2 point gain on College Career Readiness Performance Index measures. This performance will be achieved through daily best teaching practices, effective teacher collaboration, integration of technology in the classroom, and student intervention and enrichment opportunities to improve student achievement--specifically in literacy and problem solving. Non-core areas will integrate literacy and problem solving skills and content to enhance achievement in all core areas.

• Long Term Goal

Graduation Rate:

Collins Hill High School will improve the 4 year cohort graduation rate to 92% by 2019.

o Annual Goal

The 2017 4 year cohort rate was approximately 85%. The current 2018 on track cohort rate is 67% with the goal for the 2018 Cohort graduation rate being 90%.

• Long Term Goal

College and Career Readiness:

The Collins Hill Cluster Schools will increase academic knowledge and skills for college and career readiness including a focus on earning college credits, developing work habits, and increasing citizenship and civic engagement, by transforming instructional practices.

o Annual Goal

Students earning college credits in 15-16 school year was 53.02%, and those completing capstones and career pathway was 81.53%. For the 17-18 school year students earning college credits will rise by 2%, and those completing capstones and earning career pathways will rise by 3%.
