Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Balanced Literacy--Reading/Writing: Louise Radloff Middle School's students' scores on the Georgia Milestones Assessments in English/Language Arts (grades 6, 7, and 8), Math (grades 6, 7, and 8), Science (grade 8), and Social Studies (grade 8) so that 75% or more of students will be performing at or above grade level (in the Proficient Learner and Distinguished Learner categories) by 2019-20.

o Annual Goal

Louise Radloff Middle School Language Arts students will, by the end of 2019 - 2020 school year, increase the percentage of 6th grade students scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade (EOG) Assessment to 38% proficient and 10% distinguished, in 7th grade to 41% proficient and 7% distinguished and 8th grade to 45% proficient and 11% distinguished. Language Arts students will also perform at or above 50% combined proficient and distinguished on the GCPS District Assessment Posttest.

o Annual Goal

Louise Radloff Middle School Social Studies students will, by the end of 2019 - 2020 school year, increase the percentage of 8th grade students score to 45% Proficient and 15% Distinguished performance level on the Georgia Milestone End of Grade (EOG) assessment and grades 6 -8 GCPS SPG Assessment post-tests.

o Annual Goal

Louise Radloff Middle School Science students will, by the end of 2019 - 2020 school year, increase the percentage of 8th grade students score to 40% Proficient and 15% Distinguished performance level on the Physical Science Georgia Milestone End of Course(EOC) assessment and grades 6 -8 GCPS SPG Assessment post-tests.

• Long Term Goal

Balanced Numeracy: Louise Radloff Middle School's students' scores on the Georgia Milestones Assessments in Math (grades 6, 7, and 8) will increase so that 75% or more of students will be performing at or above grade level (in the Proficient Learner and Distinguished Learner categories) by 2019-20.

o Annual Goal

Louise Radloff Middle School Math students will, by the end of 2019-2020 school year, increase the percentage of 6th grade students scoring in the proficient and distinguished performance level on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade (EOG) Assessment to 37% Proficient and 10% Distinguished, in 7th grade to 35% Proficient and 15% Distinguished, 8th grade Algebra to 30% Proficient and 5% Distinguished, and Algebra to 45% Proficient and 16% Distinguished performance level on the Georgia Milestone End of Course (EOC) Algebra Assessment. Math students will also perform at or above 50% combined proficient and distinguished on the GCPS District Assessment Posttests.
