These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Arcado Elementary School will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient and Distinguished level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment (GMAS) and the End of the Year District Assessment (DA) in English Language Arts.

GMAS

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 61 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 68 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 61 or higher.

DA

Kindergarten- 85% of students will read and comprehend at a level D or higher on the End of the Year Fountas and Pinnell Reading Assessment.

First Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 75 or higher.

Second Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 60 or higher.

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 74 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 67 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 55 or higher.

GMAS

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 70 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 70 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 64 or higher.

DA

Kindergarten- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to at least 74 or higher.

First Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 86 or higher.

Second Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 84 or higher.

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 72 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 68 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 69 or higher.

By 2021, 100% of Arcado Elementary School fifth grade students will achieve at the Proficient/Distinguished level with 40% achieving at the Distinguished level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Science.

GMAS

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 67 or higher.

DA

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 63 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 77 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 78 or higher.

• Long Term Goal

By 2021, 100% of Arcado Elementary School fifth grade students will achieve at the Proficient/Distinguished level with 40% achieving at the Distinguished level on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Social Studies.

GMAS

The following scores would reflect excellent progress:

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 54 or higher.

DA

Third Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 52 or higher.

Fourth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 70 or higher.

Fifth Grade- Increase in Proficient/Distinguished percentile to 62 or higher.
