## Local School Plan for Improvement

Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. #### • Long Term Goal

All Jackson Elementary students will demonstrate mastery of the elementary language arts, math, science, and social studies AKS as indicated by 100% of students scoring in the proficient/distinguished range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment. In order to achieve this goal, the faculty of Jackson Elementary will build instructional leadership around curriculum, instruction, and assessment and will use student assessment data to drive instruction using Quality-Plus teaching strategies.

#### o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, students in grades 1-5 at Jackson Elementary will demonstrate an increase in their mastery of English/Language Arts concepts. The percentage of students in grades 1-5 scoring in the proficient/distinguished and distinguished range on the ELA DA will increase as follows:

Grade 1: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in English-Language Arts to 71% and Distinguished to 44%.

Grade 2: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in English-Language Arts to 63% and Distinguished to 30%.

Grade 3: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in English-Language Arts to 50% and Distinguished to 10% .

Grade 4: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in English-Language Arts to 58% and Distinguished to 22%.

Grade 5: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in English-Language Arts to 45% and Distinguished to 14%.

#### o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, students in grades 1-5 at Jackson Elementary will demonstrate an increase in their mastery of Mathematics concepts. The percentage of students in grades 1-5 scoring in the proficient/distinguished and distinguished range on the Math DA will increase as follows:

Grade 1: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Mathematics to 95% and Distinguished to 86% .

Grade 2: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Mathematics to 90% and Distinguished to 75%.

Grade 3: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Mathematics to 52% and Distinguished to 17%.

Grade 4: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Mathematics to 50% and Distinguished to 15%.

Grade 5: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Mathematics to 53% and Distinguished to 27%.



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#### o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, students in grades 3-5 at Jackson Elementary will demonstrate an increase in their mastery of Science concepts. The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring in the proficient/distinguished and distinguished range on the Science DA will increase as follows:

Grade 3: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Science to 31% and Distinguished to 6%.

Grade 4: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Science to 36% and Distinguished to 10%.

Grade 5: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Science to 45% and Distinguished to 15%.

#### o Annual Goal

During the 2018-2019 school year, students in grades 3-5 at Jackson Elementary will demonstrate an increase in their mastery of Social Studies concepts. The percentage of students in grades 1-5 scoring in the proficient/distinguished and distinguished range on the Social Studies DA will increase as follows:

Grade 3: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Social Studies to 15% and Distinguished to 4%.

Grade 4: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Social Studies to 20% and Distinguished to 5%.

Grade 5: Increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Social Studies to 34% and Distinguished to 8%.
