The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. Long Term Goal

Craig Elementary will increase academic performance in Mathematics and the application of Science for students in all subgroups to an acceptable goal of 80% and an excellence goal of 90% in grade levels 3, 4 and 5 on the Georgia Milestones.

o Annual Goal

Craig Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguish levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Mathematics by 2 percentage points as an acceptable goal and 5 percentage points for an excellence goal over 2015-2016 results in grade levels 3, 4 and 5.

Long Term Goal

Craig Elementary will increase academic performance in Language Arts including Reading, Writing, and the application of these skills into Science and Social Studies for students in all subgroups to meet and/or exceed an acceptable goal of 80% and an excellence goal of 90% in grade levels 3, 4 and 5 on the Georgia Milestones.

o Annual Goal

Craig Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguish levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in English Language Arts by 2 percentage points for an acceptable goal and 5 percentage points for an excellence goal over 2015-2016 results in grade levels 3, 4 and 5.

Long Term Goal

The Brookwood Cluster will increase rigor for all students to reach their greatest potential through appropriate acceleration in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math.

o Annual Goal

Craig Elementary will increase the percentage of students achieving at the Proficient or Distinguish levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in Science by 2 percentage points as an acceptable goal and 5 percentage points for an excellence over 2015-2016 results in grade 5.
