## Gwinnett County Public Schools to host job fair for substitutes

On Wednesday, October 16, from 4 to 6 p.m., Gwinnett County Public Schools will host a job fair for people interested in becoming a substitute teacher. The event will be held at <a href="Meadowcreek High School">Meadowcreek High School</a> located at 4455 Steve Reynolds Blvd. in Norcross.

Interested candidates can learn more about becoming a <u>Gwinnett substitute</u> and complete an <u>online application</u>. All applicants are required to have at least 60 semester or 90 quarter hours of college credit from an accredited institution, but teacher certification is not required for substitutes. <u>Compensation</u> ranges from \$93 a day up to \$103 per day for long-term subs (10 or more consecutive days in the same classroom).
