- **Long Term Goal**

Snellville Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies as measured by 70% of all students scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on Georgia Milestones Assessments EOG/EOC.

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2019-2020 school year, Snellville Middle School students will demonstrate academic growth and mastery in Language Arts with 50% of all students scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on the English Language Arts Georgia Milestones Assessment(EOG) and District Assessments(DA).

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2019-2020 school year, Snellville Middle School students will demonstrate academic growth and mastery in Math with 50% of students in 6th grade, 50% of students in 7th grade and 45% in 8th grade scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on the Math Georgia Milestones Assessments(EOG & EOC) and District Assessments(DA).

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2019-2020 school year, Snellville Middle School students will demonstrate academic growth and mastery in Science with 70% of 6th grade, 70% of 7th grade and 55% of 8th grade students scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on the Science Georgia Milestones Assessment (EOC) and district post-assessments(Post I and Post II).

- **Long Term Goal**

Snellville Middle School students will demonstrate academic growth and mastery in Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies measured by 70% of all students scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on district post-assessments.

- o **Annual Goal**

During the 2019-2020 school year, Snellville Middle school students will demonstrate academic growth and mastery in Social Studies with 60% of sixth grade, 60% of seventh grade and 70% of eighth grade students scoring in the proficient and distinguished learner range on Social Studies Georgia Milestones Assessments(EOG) and district post-assessments (Post I and Post II).
