Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Ivy Creek Elementary School will increase student academic performance in the area of Language Arts, consistently performing within the top 20% of Gwinnett County Elementary Schools by spring 2020.

o Annual Goal

100% of students (K-5) at Ivy Creek Elementary will show a minimum of one year's reading growth from where they began the school year as measured by the Fountas Pinnell Benchmark Reading Assessment. Students will increase post-test District Assessment scores in ELA reaching the following target scores: 1st Grade - 80%, 2nd Grade - 82%, 3rd Grade - 75%, 4th Grade - 70%, and 5th Grade 71%. Grade level National Percentiles (NPR) for the ELA Total of the Iowa Assessment will be greater than Predicted National Percentiles (PNPR) for 2nd and 5th grades. Grades 3,4, and 5 will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished categories of the Georgia Milestones ELA subtest by a minimum of 5 percentile points per grade level.

• Long Term Goal

Ivy Creek Elementary School will increase student academic performance in the area of Mathematics, consistently performing within the top 20% of Gwinnett County Elementary Schools by spring 2020.

o Annual Goal

Students in grades 3,4, and 5 will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished categories of the Georgia Milestones Mathematics subtest by a minimum of 5 percentile points per grade level. Students will increase performance on the Math Post-Test District Assessment reaching the following target scores: 1st Grade - 91%, 2nd Grade - 86%, 3rd Grade - 78%, 4th Grade - 77%, and 5th Grade - 80%. Grade level National Percentiles (NPR) for the Mathematics Total of the Iowa Assessment will be greater than Predicted National Percentiles (PNPR) for 2nd and 5th grades.
