Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

100% of students at Margaret Winn Holt Elementary will demonstrate proficiency in writing through the content areas by using grade level appropriate conventions to convey meaning through all genres.

- o **Annual Goal**

65% of our students in grades kindergarten through grade five will meet or exceed end of year grade level expectations as measured by the GCPS writing rubrics as compared to 53% in 2016-2017.

- **Long Term Goal**

100% of students at Margaret Winn Holt Elementary will read fluently with comprehension on or above grade level as a result of their learning experiences.

- o **Annual Goal**

78% of our students in grades three through five will perform on or above grade level on the Reading portion of the Georgia Milestones EOG Assessment as compared to 70% in 2016-2017 .

- **Long Term Goal**

As a result of their learning experiences at Margaret Winn Holt Elementary, 100% of students will be prepared to accurately reason, compute, and communicate mathematically in preparation for middle school by performing at the Proficient level or higher on the Georgia Milestones.

- o **Annual Goal**

60% of our students in grades three through five will perform at the Proficient Level or higher on the Mathematics portion of the Georgia Milestones EOG Assessment as compared to 45% in 2016-2017.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
