Local School Plan for Improvement

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students in grades 3 - 5 performing in the Proficient and Distinguished Learners range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Mathematics and English/ Language Arts will increase to 100%.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students in grades 3 - 5 performing in the Proficient and Distinguished Learners range on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for Mathematics and English/ Language Arts will increase as noted in the attached data file.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students who increase one performance band on ACCESS will increase by 5%, or more, above 2018-2019 results (78% to 82%).

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students who make a year's gain of reading in a year's time will increase by 5%, or more, above 2018-2019 results, as measured by Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System (from 78%-83%).

- **Long Term Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students performing in the Proficient and Distinguished Learners range on District Assessments (DA's) will meet or exceed the district average in Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

- o **Annual Goal**

The percentage of Berkeley Lake Elementary School students performing in the Proficient and Distinguished Learners range on District Assessments (DA's) will increase by 10%, or more, over 2017-2018 results, as noted in the attached data file. Kindergarten students will meet or exceed the district average on the Math DA.

- o **Annual Goal**

95% of students in grade 2 will perform on or above grade level by the end of the 2018-2019 school year, as measured by Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System.

- **Long Term Goal**

We will build our parents' capacity to support their children's academic achievement by implementing the activities identified in the Parent Involvement Policy and School/Parent Compact.
