Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

All Coleman Middle School students will score in the proficient or distinguished range on the English/Language Arts and Mathematics End of Grade Georgia Milestones Assessments by Spring 2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in language arts with 75% of all students in grade 6 -8 scoring in proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment for English/Language Arts.

At least 50% of students will score in the distinguished performance level on the District Assessments in Language Arts.

At least 50% of students will score in the distinguished performance level on the District Assessments in Social Studies.

- o **Annual Goal**

Coleman Middle School students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics with 75% of all students in grades 6 and 7 scoring in proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment (EOG) for Mathematics.

Coleman Middle school students will demonstrate mastery in mathematics with 75% of all students in grade 8 scoring in proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment (EOC) for Algebra I.

At least 50% of students will score in the distinguished performance level on the District Assessments in Mathematics.

- **Long Term Goal**

All Coleman Middle School students will score in the proficient or distinguished range on the Algebra I and Physical Science End of Course Georgia Milestone Assessments by Spring 2021.

- o **Annual Goal**

Coleman Middle school students will demonstrate mastery in science with 75% of all students in grade 8 scoring in proficient or distinguished performance levels on the Georgia Milestones Assessment (EOC) for Physical Science.

At least 50% of students will score in the exceeds performance level on the District Assessments in Science.

- **Long Term Goal**

All Coleman Middle School students will meet typical or high growth as measured in the progress section of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index by Spring 2021.
