Local School Plan for Improvement

Duncan Creek Elementary School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. • Long Term Goal

Duncan Creek Elementary School will increase student academic performance in the area of English Language Arts resulting in consistent performance in the top 20% of Gwinnett County Elementary Schools by spring 2023.

o Annual Goal

100% of students (K-5) at Duncan Creek Elementary will show a minimum of one year's reading growth from where they began the school year as measured by the Fountas Pinnell Benchmark Reading Assessment. The Total Percent Proficient category of the ELA District Assessment Pretest to post-test will increase at each grade level reaching the following targets: 1st Grade - (Pretest Score + 40 percentile points), 2nd Grade - (Pretest Score + 30 percentile points), 3rd Grade (Pretest Score + 25 percentile points), 4th Grade (Pretest Score + 25 percentile points), and 5th Grade (Pretest Score + 25 Percentile Points). Grades 3,4, and 5 will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished categories of the Georgia Milestones ELA subtest reaching the following targets: 3rd Grade - 75%, 4th Grade - 73%, and 5th Grade - 75%.

• Long Term Goal

Duncan Creek Elementary School will increase student academic performance in the area of Mathematics resulting in consistent performance in the top 20% of Gwinnett County Elementary Schools by spring 2023.

o Annual Goal

The Total Percent Proficient category of the Mathematics District Assessment Pretest to post-test will increase at each grade level reaching the following targets: Kdg. - (Pretest + # greater than the district average) 1st Grade - (Pretest Score + 45 percentile points), 2nd Grade - (Pretest Score + 40 percentile points), 3rd Grade (Pretest Score + 40 percentile points), 4th Grade (Pretest Score + 50 percentile points), and 5th Grade (Pretest Score + 40 Percentile Points). Students in grades 3,4, and 5 will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished categories of the Georgia Milestones Mathematics sub-test reaching the following targets: 3rd Grade - 84%, 4th Grade - 85%, and 5th Grade - 69%.
