Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

All students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will demonstrate proficiency on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of English/Language Arts. Additionally, 40% of all students will demonstrate proficiency at the "distinguished" level by the year 2018.

- o **Annual Goal**

Mountain Park Elementary will increase student achievement in literacy with the following end-of-year (EOY) indicator:

Increase EOY district assessment results in ELA over 2015-2016 results for each grade level:

Grade 1 from 50 % proficient to 75 % proficient of which 30% will exceed; up from 24% for EOY in 2016
Grade 2 from 68 % proficient to 84 % proficient of which 32% will exceed; up from 26% for EOY in 2016
Grade 3 from 62 % proficient to 81 % proficient of which 42% will exceed; up from 36% for EOY in 2016
Grade 4 from 44 % proficient to 72 % proficient of which 20% will exceed; up from 5% for EOY in 2016
Grade 5 from 77 % proficient to 89 % proficient of which 35% will exceed; up from 29% for EOY in 2016

- **Long Term Goal**

All students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will demonstrate proficiency on the Georgia Milestones Assessment in the area of Math. Additionally, 40% of all students will demonstrate proficiency at the "distinguished" level by the year 2018.

- o **Annual Goal**

Mountain Park Elementary will increase student achievement in math with the following end-of-year (EOY) indicator:

Increase EOY district assessment results in Math over 2015-2016 results for each grade level:

Grade 1 from 90 % proficient to 94 % proficient of which 75% will exceed; up from 72% for EOY in 2016
Grade 2 from 80 % proficient to 90 % proficient of which 67% will exceed; up from 55% for EOY in 2016
Grade 3 from 66 % proficient to 82 % proficient of which 40% will exceed; up from 32% for EOY in 2016
Grade 4 from 50 % proficient to 75 % proficient of which 39% will exceed; up from 27% for EOY in 2016
Grade 5 from 57 % proficient to 78 % proficient of which 30% will exceed; up from 21% for EOY in 2016
