Local School Plan for Improvement

Hull Middle School

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Accountability and flexibility are hallmarks of Gwinnett County Public Schools' success. Key to that success is ensuring that each school community understands the progress being made by its schools, as well as what plans will drive improvement. Each school creates a collaborative Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI), with targeted goals based on student achievement results. These goals are dynamic, like our schools, and are updated to reflect changes that occur in schools. Data is used to determine areas needing improvement and to identify specific, measurable, annual objectives. Schools then determine how to use research-based strategies to achieve these goals, using flexibility as needed. The LSPI development process involves teachers, parents, and community members, so the entire school community has the opportunity to be involved in conversations about school improvement. - **Long Term Goal**

By 2018-2019, 80 percent of Hull Middle School's students will score 80% or better on the district assessments in all content areas.

- **Long Term Goal**

Hull Middle School students will demonstrate high growth evidenced by a median score greater than the 90th percentile in all content areas on all state assessments by 2018-2019.

- **Annual Goal**

LANGUAGE ARTS: During the 2017-2018 school year, Hull Middle School will increase the students scoring in the proficient and distinguished domains as measured by the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment in language arts to 77%, 82%, and 77% for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades, respectively.

- **Annual Goal**

MATH: During the 2017-2018 school year, Hull Middle School will increase the students scoring in the combined proficient and distinguished domains as measured by the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment in mathematics to 81%, 79%, and 50% for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades, respectively. We will also increase the percentage of students scoring in the combined proficient and distinguished domains to 96% as measured by the End-of-Course Algebra Assessment.

- **Annual Goal**

SCIENCE: During the 2017-2018 school year, Hull Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the combined proficient and distinguished domains as measured by district assessments in science to 83% during semesters 1 and 2 for 6th grade; 81% during semester 1 and 86% in semester 2 for 7th grade. We will also increase the percentage of 8th grade students scoring in the combined proficient and distinguished domains to 63% as measured on the Georgia Milestones End-of-Course Assessment for Physical Science.

- **Annual Goal**

SOCIAL STUDIES: During the 2017-2018 school year, Hull Middle School will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished domains as measured by district assessments in social studies to 72% during semester 1 and 77% during semester 2 for 6th grade and 66% during semester 1 and 82% during semester 2 for 7th grade. We will also increase the percentage of students scoring in the combined proficient and distinguished domains to 74% as measured on the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment in social studies.

- **Annual Goal**

LITERACY: During the 2017-2018 school year, Hull Middle School will increase student performance on the Evidence Based Reading and Writing overall mean score of the PSAT 8 by seven points by focusing on the subsections of Command of Evidence, Vocabulary in Context, and Expression of Ideas.
