## **GCPS to host Child Find event on Friday, November 1**

**Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS)** will host an information meeting for families of children with disabilities on **Friday, November 1**. Interested parties can drop in between **9 a.m. to noon** at the **J. Alvin Wilbanks Instructional Support Center located at 437 Old Peachtree Road NW, in Suwanee**. The meeting will take place in the **Central Gwinnett Room 2.111 in Building 200**.

Attendees to the **Child Find** meeting will receive information about services available through the school system to support students with disabilities. Child Find works to identify and support students, (ages 3-21), with disabilities who are currently enrolled in private or home school programs in Gwinnett County.

If families are not able to attend the November 1 event and believe they may have a child with a disability who may be eligible for special education services, or if they have questions, they may contact the GCPS Parent Mentors or the Office of Compliance.
